

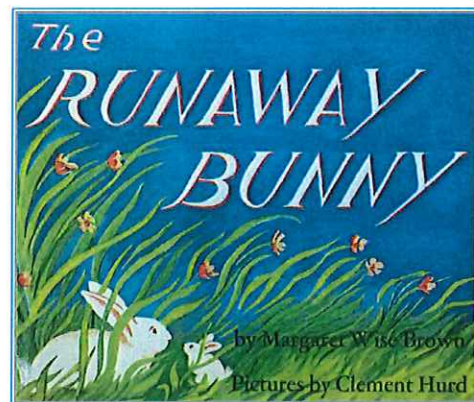
My Special Visit to the Easter Bunny
